WHAT

In my workshop we will be exploring the relationship between artificial intelligence and human expression. By taking simple prompts generated by ChatGPT and interpreting them using abstract shapes and countless uses of color, I hope to share with the class what I have discovered in my own process, which is that both AI and human expression have a place in the world.

WHY

In my research I have been exploring the processes and the way AI receives its data from the Internet. In my finding I have come to a conclusion that no matter how accurate the generated data is, something is missing to make it feel genuine. Human interaction is very important to the use of AI and the human touch is what makes simple data conclusions engaging and beautiful.

HOW

Step one:

To have each student enter a prompt into ChatGPT to begin expressing data. These prompts can be anything the student chooses, they only need to make sure to have a clear key on how they map translates.

Step two:

The student will have a choice of pigments and will apply with tissues and alcohol to pieces of hand-made paper to create colorful splatters.

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Step three:

Will be to trace each splatter of color with black or multicolor pens. (Students are not limited to just tracing, they are free to mark each page in however way they plane to express themselves)

Step four: the pieces will then be collected and used to further in my research prompts regarding the colors of inclusion.
